Registering as a Trainer and Assessor with DrillSkill Training

1. Trainer and Assessor
(possessing both Certificate IV in Training And Assessment and appropriate Qualifications in Drilling)
2. Assessor
(Workplace Assessor Qualifications and appropriate Qualifications in Drilling)

The advantages of Registered Workplace Trainers / Assessors are:

- Industry can train and assess their own drilling personnel;

The Registration Process
