BSBMGT401A - Show Leadership in the Workplace

This unit covers the performance outcomes, skills and knowledge required to work with teams and individuals, their standard of conduct and the initiative they take in influencing others. At this level, work will normally be carried out within routine and non-routine methods and procedures which require the exercise of some discretion and judgment.

RIIBEF402A - Supervise On Site Operations

This unit covers the supervision of on-site operations in the resources and infrastructure industries. It includes managing on-site safety, communicating regularly with others, diagnosing and solving routine and non-routine problems, controlling work programs to ensure objectives are met, coordinating work of the team and maintaining operating records.

RIIRIS301A - Apply Risk Management Processes

This unit covers the application of risk management processes associated with identifying hazards, assessing and identifying unacceptable risk, identifying and recommending treatments, contributing to the implementation of treatments and reviewing safety system documentation.

RIICOM301A - Communicate Information

This unit covers the communication of information orally and in writing, achieving meeting outcomes, making presentations and participating in negotiations.

RIINHB402A - Supervise Mineral Exploration Drilling Operations

This unit covers the supervision of mineral exploration drilling operations in mining and extractive industries. This includes, planning and preparing for operations, initiating the operations, and monitoring, adjusting, communicating and reporting on the execution of the operations.
